TICKET FAQ

When do tickets go on sale?

May 1st. Pre-sale access for volunteers opens April 24th.

Who needs to purchase a ticket?

Anyone who sits inside the theatre to watch the performance is required to purchase a ticket. Lap children do not need to purchase a ticket.

Ushers will have a seat provided for them during the show they are volunteering for in order to enforce house rules. Chaperones will be provided with a complimentary seat during the show they are volunteering for in order to watch when it's their dancer's time to perform.

Is the theatre assigned seating?

Yes. You will have the option of choosing your seats at the time of your purchase.

Want early access? Show volunteers get to purchase tickets one week prior to the on-sale date!

How much do tickets cost?

Tickets are \$24 for all ages. There is an additional small service fee charged by the ticketing company for online and phone sales.

Can I get a refund or exchange my tickets?

Refunds are allowed only on same day of purchase. Exchanges are allowed for purchases of equal or higher amount.

*Please double check the day and time of the show you are purchasing tickets for, as well as which shows your dancer is performing in.

How do I purchase tickets?

Tickets are sold online and by phone only until the day of the first show. Online and phone sales will be shut off the morning of Friday, June 14th. Tickets will then be available at the door one hour before show time. Door tickets will only be sold for the upcoming performance (i.e. you cannot purchase a 7pm Saturday ticket during the 2pm Saturday sales).
